### RESPONDING TO THE WORD

**\*Affirmation of Faith-** *The Second Helvetic Confession (1561)*

[THE TIME NECESSARY FOR WORSHIP.] **Although religion is not bound to time, yet it cannot be cultivated and exercised without a proper distribution and arrangement of time. Every Church, therefore, chooses for itself a certain time for public prayers, and for the preaching of the Gospel, and for the celebration of the sacraments; and no one is permitted to**

overthrow this appointment of the Church at his own pleasure. For unless some due time and leisure is given for the outward exercise of religion, without doubt people\* would be drawn away from it by their own affairs.

[THE LORD'S DAY.] Hence we see that in the ancient churches there were not only certain set hours in the week appointed for meetings, but that also the Lord's Day itself, ever since the apostles' time, was set aside for them and for a holy rest, a practice now rightly preserved by our Churches for the sake of worship and love.
